## Pharaoh Refuses to Listen

Exodus 3:11-22; 12:40-41

(KBC Study Bible, pages 65-66 and 77)

### Character Word

**Humility** – to value others above yourself; opposite of prideful, arrogant and conceited

Pharaoh's pride blinded him to the mighty acts and authority of God, and so he and all of Egypt suffered severe consequences.

With God's help, I can be humble.

### Weekly Challenge

Ask an adult to help you identify some things you did to show humilty.

### **DAY 1 READ: Proverbs 22:4** (KBC Study Bible, page 690)

**DO:** In this verse, "fear the Lord" does not mean fear like a fear of spiders or snakes. This fear means to respect and value. Write down three things this verse says we'll have if we are humble and fear the Lord.

**PRAY:** Thank You, Jesus, for humbly dying on the cross for my sins. Help me, Jesus, to be humble and honor You. In Jesus' name, Amen.

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#### DAY 2 READ: Philippians 2:3-4 (KBC Bible, pages 1294-1295)

**DO:** These verses tell us to put others before ourselves. Write down three things you can do to demonstrate putting others first.

**PRAY:** Lord, I don't want to be selfish or conceited. Help me to put others first before myself. In Jesus' name, Amen.

### **DAY 3** READ: Colossians 3:12-17 (KBC Bible, page 1302)

**THINK:** Think about your day today. How did you act toward your friends at school, your parents or your teachers? Did you act the way this verse tells us to act – with tenderness, kindness, humility and forgiveness?

**PRAY:** Jesus, I ask You to help me treat others with tenderness, kindness, humility and forgiveness. In Jesus' name, Amen.

#### DAY 4 READ: 1 Peter 5:5-11 (KBC Bible, page 1351)

**SHARE:** Share with a sibling, parent or grandparent what you learned in Beach Club. Tell them you're sorry for times you have acted proudly and that you'll ask Jesus to help you practice humility.

**PRAY:** Thank You, God, for family that loves me. Father, help me to be humble and to honor and respect my family. In Jesus' name, Amen.

#### DAY 5 READ: Exodus 6:1-8 (KBC Bible, page 68)

**DO:** Look at the decoder at the bottom of page 68. The word redeem means to buy something back from someone. God bought back the Israelites from Egyptian slavery. Jesus bought us back from the slavery of sin.

**PRAY:** Dear God, thank You for redeeming me and for forgiving me from my sin. In Jesus' name, Amen.

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
