PRAY: Thank You, God, that I can depend on Your faithfulness to last longer than I can imagine. Amen.

PRAY: You are dependable, God, to offer salvation as a free gift. Thank You! Amen.

DAY 5 READ: Psalm 119:89-90a (KBC Study Bible, page 645)

THINK: Can you think of a time someone made a promise and let you down? God won't! You can depend on God to faithfully keep His promises (faithfulness) throughout all time (endures) and for all people who ever lived (generations).

PRAY: God, thank You for being dependable! In Jesus' name, Amen.

DAY 2 READ: Malachi 3:6a (KBC Study Bible, page 1018)
