Character Word

Confidence – *trust; a feeling of assurance or certainty*

Weekly Challenge

God wants you to have complete confidence in Him. Confidence means trusting Him to know what's best for you and to be with you no matter what. This week, share with family members something you did when you knew God was with you.

☐ **DAY 1 READ: Joshua 1:9** (KBC Study Bible, page 226)

THINK: God has promised us that He will be with us wherever we go. He wants us to have confidence in Him so that we can have courage and be strong.

PRAY: God, I trust You to be with me wherever I am. In Jesus' name, Amen.

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☐ **DAY 2** READ: **Philippians 1:6** (KBC Study Bible, page 1293)

THINK: God never starts something He can't finish. God started a good thing in your life when you first heard about Jesus. You can be confident that He will continue to be with you as you learn more about Jesus.

PRAY: God, I know that learning about Jesus is a good thing that You have started in my life and that You will continue to be with me. In Jesus' name, Amen.

☐ **DAY 3** READ: **Proverbs 3:5-6** (KBC Study Bible, page 666)

DO: Draw a heart on a sheet of paper, then color it. Color all of it; not just part of it. God wants you to trust Him with your whole heart; not just part of it. Write on the picture of your heart some of the ways you can trust God.

PRAY: God, I trust You with all my heart. I have confidence in You. In Jesus' name, Amen.

☐ **DAY 4** READ: **Philippians 4:13** (KBC Study Bible, page 1298)

DO: Write down one thing that you know you need God's strength to do. Make sure that is it something you know God would approve of. Be confident that God will help you do it.

PRAY: God, I need Your strength to help me do what I have written down. In Jesus' name, Amen.

☐ **DAY 5** READ: **Hebrews 13:6** (KBC Study Bible, page 1338)

DO: "Boldly" means with great confidence. Tell someone today that the LORD is your helper. Share with them about a time that God helped you. Tell it to them boldly.

PRAY: God, help me remember that You are my helper. In Jesus' name, Amen.

☐ **DAY 2** READ: **Philippians 1:6** (KBC Study Bible, page 1293)
