Weekly Challenge

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DAY 1 READ: Psalm 56:3 (KBC Study Bible, page 598) THINK: In this week's Bible story, Moses selected 12 men as spies. Ten of them focused on what they feared. What do you fear? How can you trust God to give you the courage to face your fears? Tell God about your fears. PRAY: Dear God, when I am afraid, help me have the courage to trust in You. In Jesus' name, Amen.
DAY 2 READ: Numbers 14:9b (KBC Study Bible, page 159) DO: Draw a picture of a situation where you need God to be with you. In your picture, draw God standing with you giving you courage.
PRAY: Dear God, thank You for always being with me. In Jesus' name, Amen.
DAY 3 READ: Numbers 14:6-10 (KBC Study Bible, page 159) THINK: Joshua and Caleb were the only only ones who stood up against the crowd for what was right. They trusted God to be with them and keep His promise to give them the land. Think about ways you can stand up for God's truth, even if you are the only one. Be strong and courageous!
PRAY: Father, I want to have the courage to stand up for You just like Joshua and Caleb. Please help me. In Jesus' name, Amen.
DAY 4 READ: Deuteronomy 31:6 (KBC Study Bible, page 218) DO: Read "Digging In" on page 159 in your KBC Study Bible. With God on your side, you can have the courage to see things from His point of view.
PRAY: Father, help me to daily look for Your side of a situation. In Jesus' name, Amen.
DAY 5 READ: Ephesians 6:10-18 (KBC Study Bible, pages 1291-92) DO: God has given you armor to help you fight against the evil that tries to penetrate your heart and mind. Make a list of the weapons God provides for you. These weapons from God can give you courage to do what's right.
