DAY 1 READ: John 3:16 (KBC Study Bible, page 1151)	
DO: In John 3:16, circle the word "whoever" in your Bible and write your name out to the side. Read the verse replacing "whoever" with your name. Remember how much God loves you and that you can have everlasting life when you place your confidence, or trust, in Jesus.	
PRAY: Thank You, God, for loving me enough to send Jesus to die in my place. In Jesus' name, amen.	
DAY 2 READ: Romans 6:23 (KBC Study Bible, page 1236)	
DO: Find "How to Know God" in your KBC Study Bible (between pages 626-627). You can be confident that God offers salvation as a free gift. You can ADMIT you are a sinner, BELIEVE that Jesus is the Son of God, and CHOOSE TO FOLLOW Him by making Him your Lord and Savior.	
PRAY: God, I was born a sinner. Thank You for offering salvation through Jesus as a free gift. In Jesus' name, amen.	
DAY 3 READ: Romans 10:9-10 (KBC Study Bible, page 1241)	
THINK: To confess sin means to agree with God that you were born a sinner. God already knows all about you. Nothing you tell Him is a surprise. He is ready to forgive all your sin. Pray and agree with God about your sin nature. Tell God you believe Jesus was sent to pay for your sin.	
PRAY: Dear God, I am confident in Your word and believe that You forgive my sin. Thank You. In Jesus' name, amen.	
DAY 4 Romans 5:8 (KBC Study Bible, page 1235)	
THINK: You can be confident in God's love for you. He loved you so much that He sent Jesus to die on the cross to pay for your sin. No one loves you like God does. You can't earn God's love and you don't deserve it. But you can believe what God says and thank Him for loving you perfectly.	
PRAY: Dear God, thank You for loving me. Help me be confident that Your love for me never changes. In Jesus' name, amen.

DAY 5 READ: John 14:6 (KBC Study Bible, page 1171)

THINK: The Bible clearly teaches that there is only one way for you to make things right with God and that is through Jesus. You must place your confidence in Jesus as the only way to God. There is no other way to God except through Jesus.

PRAY: Dear God, thank You for sending Jesus to pay for my sin so that I can be with You today and forever. In Jesus' name, amen.
