

Policies and Procedures

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The entire KBC Child Protection Policy is available in the KBC Leadership Manual Volumes 1 & 2, on the NEW KBC App, and on the KBC website. It's important for volunteers to not only read and know the policy, but we require that every volunteer agree to abide by it as part of the application process.

Volunteer Background Check – Required for Every Adult Volunteer 18 and Older!

In an effort to stay above reproach with our partnering school districts, all adult volunteers are required to complete a volunteer background check annually, doing our part to keep all children and volunteers protected and safe. Please note, you cannot use a mobile or tablet device to complete the background check; you must use a desktop or laptop computer.

Volunteer Background Check Process

- 1. Go to KiDsBeachClub.org/volunteers
- 2. Watch the **Policies and Procedures** video
- 3. Read the KBC Child Protection Policy and the KBC Statement of Faith below the video
- 4. Click the box to let us know you have watched the video and read the two documents
- 5. Read below and **click the box** to agree to the terms and conditions then **complete the Volunteer Registration Form**; let us know you're not a robot!
- 6. Click Submit & Continue to Background Check
- 7. Click the purple "Please Click Here to Complete National Background Check"
- 8. Select **District** from the list of **Current Ministry Opportunities** in the left column to fill out your background check application
- 9. In the right column, select School
- 10. From the next screen, click Proceed
- 11. In the pop-up box, click Yes to continue giving us permission to run your background check
- 12. Enter all required Personal Information
- 13. Continue through application before submitting

Teen Helpers

- All volunteers, with the exception of Teen Helpers, must complete the online "Volunteer Background Check" annually.
- Volunteers under the age of 18 must complete the Teen Helper Application (found on the Club Leader Tools Page) AND begin the online "Volunteer Background Check." Teen helpers should watch the video, read the two documents, continue to the "Volunteer Registration Form," then STOP when prompted click the orange National Background Check button.
- Teen Helpers must serve alongside an approved adult volunteer and do not count in your adultto-student ratio.
- Maximum ratio of one adult leader for every 10 kids.



Permission Forms (online or paper version)

- Parents must give permission for a student to attend Beach Club preferably using the online registration form. A paper version is available if necessary.
- Enter all information from the paper registration forms into the KiDs Online Management System (KOMS) promptly and accurately.
- Must have original or printed copies of all permission forms with you at club or a mobile device to access them.
- Note allergies, medical conditions and special needs.

Keeping Kids and Leaders Safe

- Be prepared before kids arrive.
- Two-adult rule NEVER be alone with a student. NO EXCEPTIONS. Stay where other leaders can see you. Two non-related adults need to be present when there is just one student.
- Three-person rule May be used when situations arise where a student needs to be in a different location (i.e., restroom, decision counseling, etc.) and MUST include at least one adult.
- Have an organized plan for dismissal.
- Two non-related adults must stay until the last student is picked up.
- We are never allowed to give students a ride home. Our liability insurance only protects students and volunteers from the club to the curb.

OUCH Reports

- Informs parents and school administration of injury. In a serious medical emergency, call 911 first and then the student's parents.
- Informs parents and school administration of behavioral problems.

Reporting Abuse

- You will find the definition of child abuse as defined by the Federal Child Abuse Prevention and Treatment Act (CAPTA) in the Safety & Security sections of your leadership manuals.
- Suspicions of abuse or neglect MUST be reported.
- All reports are held in strictest confidence.
- Keep a copy of the KBC Child Protection Policy (found in the KBC Leadership Manuals Volumes 1 & 2 and the Club Leader Tools page on the KBC website) readily available at Beach Club. It may also be found on the NEW KBC App if you have it downloaded on your mobile device.

Photos and Video

- Parent permission to photograph/video their student is given when a student is registered, unless the parent indicates otherwise.
- Protect the privacy of students when posting pictures to social media. Make sure their last name is not visible on their name tag, on their Bible, in published photos or video.

Spiritual Protection

- Present God's word age appropriately and responsibly.
- Clearly present the gospel and give students opportunities to respond.
- Follow up is key!

Video Training Portal

The Video Training Portal is an online resource, which features each aspect of Beach Club and additional club-related topics on video and makes them available all in one place for your convenience. - Every new student in Beach Club will receive a KBC Study Bible. Churches are responsible to place their Bible orders following their third week of club. The Great Treasure Day Bible order form is located on the Club Leader Tools page. Bibles will be shipped directly to churches or arrangements can be made for pick up through your Club Relations Specialist.

Leadership T-Shirts

The 2022 Leadership t-shirt is a blue cotton shirt which proudly displays the KiDs Beach Club® logo on the front and what we do on the back, which is "Connecting KiDs to Christ and Putting Bibles in Their Hands."
