Character Word

Compassion – feeling for another's need and helping that one without expecting anything in return

Jonah received <u>compassion</u> from God but did not extend <u>compassion</u> to others.

I can know that God shows me compassion when I repent.

Memory Link

"And be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God in Christ forgave you."

DAY 1 READ: Ephesians 4:32 (KBC Study Bible, page 1289)

THINK: God wants us to treat one another well. We should love others as He loves us. Think of 5 people that you can show God's love to this week. Who can you help? Who can you encourage? Who can you forgive?

PRAY: Dear God, thank You for the way that You love me. Please give me opportunities to show that love to others. Amen.

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DAY 2 READ: 2 Samuel 9:1-13 (KBC Study Bible, pages 331-332)

THINK: Because he was crippled, Mephibosheth would have felt hopeless and helpless. But David showed him compassion. Who can you help today? And who needs to hear the hope of Jesus Christ?

PRAY: Dear God, thank You that with Jesus we are never without hope. Like David, may I show compassion to someone who may feel hopeless and needs help. Amen.

DAY 3 READ: Luke 10:30-37 (KBC Study Bible, pages 1122-1123)

THINK: Jesus told this story to teach people about true love and compassion. Think of a neighbor who may need God's love and compassion and see how you can follow the Samaritan's example.

PRAY: Dear God, thank You for loving us – all of us. Help me to see those around me through Your eyes and with Your compassion. Amen.

DAY 4 READ: Matthew 18:21-27 (KBC Study Bible, page 1051)

THINK: Forgiveness is a funny thing. If we stay mad at someone it hurts us – often times more than it hurts the one we are choosing to not forgive. God showed forgiveness to us and we need to show forgiveness to others.

PRAY: Dear God, thank You for the way that You so quickly forgive me when I sin. Help me forgive others just that easily. Amen.

DAY 5 READ: Jonah 3:3-10 (KBC Study Bible, pages 978-979)

THINK: Jonah was sent by God to warn the people of Nineveh. The people listened to Jonah and they turned from their sin. Because of that, God chose to not destroy Nineveh. There's no doubt that they felt the great compassion of God. We can know that God shows us compassion when we repent.

PRAY: Dear God, thank You for Your compassion. Thank You for the forgiveness that You show when we confess our sins to You. In Jesus' name, Amen.

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
