# GOD'S WORD...

## ...so LOVE IT! LEARN IT! LIVE IT!

**LEARNING FROM THE BIBLE DOESN'T HAVE TO BE BORING.** Try some of these fun ways to get the Bible into your brain. You might even play some of these games at your KiDs Beach Club\*.

TRY IT! Find the suggested pages in the center of this Bible.

### **SORT IT**

- Get Bible events and facts in the correct order.
- Write each event/fact on a separate card. Mix up the cards. Try to put the cards in the right order. Use a stopwatch and try to get faster each time. Make two sets of cards and race against a friend.
- TRY IT! Use "Ten Commandments" or "Fruit of the Spirit"

#### MIRROR IT

- Memorize a verse or Bible passage.
- Write out the verse on a large mirror, like in your bathroom. Review the words as you brush
  your teeth each morning and evening. Erase a word or two at a time until you can say the
  whole verse from memory. Ask a family member to erase words while you're not looking.
  You try to figure out which ones are missing.
- TRY IT! Use "Bible Verses To Help When You Feel..." or "A Song of Praise to God"

#### **MATCH IT**

- Remember where to find stuff in the Bible.
- Write what you want to remember (story title, Bible verse) on a card with the reference
  (Book, chapter, verse) on a separate card. Make as many sets of cards as you like. Place all
  the cards face down. Turn over two cards at a time. Use your Bible to check for matches.
  If they don't match, turn the cards back over. If they do match, keep the cards. Compete
  against a friend to see who can collect the most matches.
- Try matching other things, like character words matched with their definitions or examples.
- TRY IT! Use "God Is...", "Jesus: The Perfect Example" or "Character Words"

#### **NAME IT**

- · Remember who did what in the Bible.
- Select a person from the Bible. Write three facts about that person from their point of view.
   Example: I was born in a stable. I fed 5000 people. I died on a cross. Ask a friend or family member to read the statements back to you. Respond saying, "Hello, My Name Is \_\_\_\_\_"
   Example: Jesus. Challenge a friend to create her own facts and try to stump each other!
- TRY IT! Use "Bible Heroes" or "Children of the Bible"

#### **FIND IT**

- Practice finding Bible books and verses.
- Hold your closed Bible in front of you. Ask a friend or family member to call out the name of
  a Bible book as they start a stopwatch. When you find the book say "Got it!" so your friend
  will know to stop the timer. Practice finding books and improving your time. Hint: It's helpful
  to memorize the books of the Bible in order so you don't have to use the Table of Contents.
   Set up a competition with kids in your KiDs Beach Club® to see who's got the fastest fingers.
- TRY IT! Use the Table of Contents and try to find every book in the Bible as fast as you can.
