HANG 10 PARENT COMPANION LESSON 4: KINDNESS

BOAZ SHOWS KINDNESS Ruth 2:3-8, 14-18, 23 (KBC Study Bible, pages 282-283)

CHARACTER WORD: Kindness - A friendly, good-natured attitud toward of

MEMORY LINK

"Blessed be he...who has not forsaken his kindness to the living." Ruth 2:20b (KBC Study Bible, page 283)

WEEKLY CHALLENGE for KIDs

Keep a daily journal this week to record your acts of kindness. The goal is to show kindness to at least one person each day this week.

WEEKLY CONNECTION

READ the Scripture for each day on your own. Using the prompts below, take 10 minutes during the day to discuss it with them, either in the car, at the table or by their bed.

DAY 1: READ 1 Thessalonians 5:11 (KBC Study Bible, page 1307)

ASK: What does it mean to edify others? How can you use your words to build others up? How can you show kindness through your words?

DAY 2: READ Ephesians 4:32 (KBC Study Bible, page 1289)

ASK: What does it mean to forgive others? How is forgiveness a form of kindness? Is there someone you need to farrive?

DAY 3: READ Luke 6:31 (KBC Study Bible, page 1113)

ASK: What is the "Golden Rule"? How can you apply it in your life? How does it relate to showing kindness?

DAY 4: READ Galatians 6:9 (KBC Study Bible, page 1284)

ASK: Why should we continue to do good even when others don't appreciate it? How can you show kindness even when it's hard?

DAY 5: READ 1 Corinthians 13:4 (KBC Study Bible, page 1261)

ASK: How can you show love through patience and kindness? How can you apply this in your family?

PRAYER: Pray this prayer daily for your child this week.

"Lord, give my child a heart that is kind and forgiving. Help them to show love to others through their actions and words. May they understand the importance of kindness and apply it in their daily life. In Your name I pray, Amen."

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HANG 10 PARENT COMPANION WELCOME LESSON: DEPENDABILITY

WELCOME TO BEACH CLUB®!

CHARACTER WORD: Dependability – trustworthy to do what I say I will do.

MEMORY LINK

"You shall walk in all the ways which the Lord your God has commanded you." Deuteronomy 5:33a (KBC Study Bible, page 193)

WEEKLY CHALLENGE for KiDs

It's the first week of Beach Club® and time to start building a good habit of spending time with God every day. Decide WHEN and WHERE you will spend time with God. Gather up WHAT you need, like your Bible and a pen. Write down your plans. Tell your surf team leader your plans next week.

WEEKLY CONNECTION

READ the Scripture for each day on your own. Using the prompts below, take 10 minutes during the day to discuss it with them, either in the car, at the table or by their bed.

DAY 1: READ Deuteronomy 5:33a (KBC Study Bible, page 193)

ASK: What did you learn about the Old and New Testaments today, and how can you use the additional resources in your Bible to deepen your understanding of God's Word?

DAY 2: READ Deuteronomy 12:28 (KBC Study Bible, page 200)

ASK: What does it mean to observe and obey God's Word, and how can you apply this in your daily life at school, home, and with friends?

DAY 3: READ John 15:12-17 (KBC Study Bible, pages 1172-1173)

ASK: How can you show love to another person today, as God has commanded us to love one another in these verses?

DAY 4: READ Romans 12:18 (KBC Study Bible, page 1244)

ASK: What are some ways you can help promote peace among your siblings, classmates, and friends, as suggested in these verses?

DAY 5: READ Deuteronomy 5:33a (KBC Study Bible, page 193)

ASK: Which of this week's Bible verses was your favorite and why? How can you share what you've learned at KiDs Beach Club® with a friend?

PRAYER: Pray this prayer daily for your child this week.

"Lord, thank You for the example of Joshua and Caleb, who stood alone, courageously trusting in Your promises. I ask that You instill in my child the same courage to stand for and trust in You, even when they feel alone. May they always remember that You are with them. In Jesus' name, I pray, Amen."

HANG 10 PARENT COMPANION LESSON 1: OBEDIENCE

NOAH OBEYS GOD Genesis 6:6-22; 8:8-12 (KBC Study Bible, pages 8-11)

CHARACTER WORD: Obedience - Doing what I am told to do with a happy, submissive spirit.

Noah **obeyed** all the instructions God gave him.

I can **obey** God even in the face of challenging situations.

MEMORY LINK

"Thus Noah did; according to all that God commanded him, so he did." Genesis 6:22

WEEKLY CHALLENGE for KiDs

To let their parents know that they will try to be obedient this week and make right choices.

WEEKLY CONNECTION

READ the Scripture for each day on your own. Using the prompts below, take 10 minutes during the day to discuss it with them, either in the car, at the table or by their bed.

DAY 1: READ Ephesians 6:1-3 (KBC Study Bible, pg. 1291)

ASK: Why does the Bible say kids should obey their parents? When is this hard for you? What difference does your attitude make when we you obey?

DAY 2: READ Titus 3:1 (KBC Study Bible, pg. 1322)

ASK: What authorities did you think of that you are to obey? What authorities am I to obey? Are there ever times when it is okay to not obey them? Who is the ultimate authority?

DAY 3: READ Hebrews 11:8 (KBC Study Bible, pg. 1335)

ASK: Why is it hard to obey when you want to do the opposite? If God loves us, can we trust Him to be with us when He asks us to do something? Is obeying about what is familiar/easy for us? What is obeying about?

DAY 4: READ Deuteronomy 6:18 (KBC Study Bible, pg. 194)

ASK: What does it mean to do right in the sight of the Lord? What other people or groups might want us to do what they say is right? How do we know what God says is right?

DAY 5: READ Proverbs 20:11 (KBC Study Bible, pg. 688)

ASK: Are we more likely to try to please those we love or those we don't like? When we try to please God by obeying His Word, what does that say to others and to Him? Does God love us more when we obey?

PRAYER: Pray this prayer daily for your child this week.

"Lord, give my child a desire to love and follow You with all of their heart, in all they do, and above all else. May they know Your grace and mercy no matter their behavior. Give them a heart to respect authority and serve others generously. In Your name I pray, Amen."

HANG 10 PARENT COMPANION LESSON 2: RESPONSIBILITY

MIRIAM WATCHES MOSES Exodus 2:1-10 (KBC Study Bible, pages 8-11)

CHARACTER WORD: Responsibility - To be accountable for my behavior.

Miriam acted **responsibly** in obeying her mother and watching over Moses. I can be **responsible** for my own actions.

MEMORY LINK

"So then each of us shall give account of himself to God." Romans 14:12 (KBC Study Bible, page 1246)

WEEKLY CHALLENGE for KiDs

To let their parents know that they will try to be obedient this week and make right choices. Ask an adult in your home to give you three responsibilities this week. Remember to do them with all your heart as if you were doing it for God.

WEEKLY CONNECTION

READ the Scripture for each day on your own. Using the prompts below, take 10 minutes during the day to discuss it with them, either in the car, at the table or by their bed.

DAY 1: READ Ephesians 6:1-3 (KBC Study Bible, page 1291)

ASK: How can you honor (or obey) the people who take care of you? How can you take responsibility for your own actions?

DAY 2: READ "The Bible is God's Word" tip-in pages at the very back of your KBC Study Bible

ASK: Why is God's Word important? How can you love it, learn it, and live it?

DAY 3: READ Galatians 6:4-5 (KBC Study Bible, page 1283)

ASK: What can you do for yourself? When should you ask for help?

DAY 4: READ John 6:9-13 (KBC Study Bible, page 1156)

ASK: How can you take responsibility to share with others? How can you notice what others need?

DAY 5: READ Genesis 1:31 (KBC Study Bible, page 2)

ASK: How can you take care of your world? What can you recycle?

PRAYER: Pray this prayer daily for your child this week.

"Lord, help my child to be responsible for their actions. Give them the strength to honor their family and those who care for them. Help them to love, learn, and live Your Word. Guide them to see when they can do things on their own and when they need help. Encourage them to share with others and to take care of the world You have given us. In Your name I pray, Amen."

HANG 10 PARENT COMPANION LESSON 3: COURAGE

JOSHUA & CALEB STAND UP FOR GOD Numbers 13:1-3, 17-21; 23-33; 14:1-9 (KBC Study Bible, pages 158-159)

CHARACTER WORD: Courage - standing up for what I believe in; bravery.

Joshua and Caleb stand alone, **courageously** trusting in God to keep His promise. I can have **courage** to stand for God because He is with me.

MEMORY LINK

"The Lord is with us. Do not fear them." Numbers 14:9b (KBC Study Bible, page 159)

WEEKLY CHALLENGE for KiDs

Look at "Making Jesus Cool at School®," which is found on the very last tip-in page of your KBC Study Bible. With God's help, you can have the courage to make Jesus cool at YOUR school. Choose one or two of the ideas listed and write them down. Tell your surf team leader how you plan to Make Jesus Cool at School®.

WEEKLY CONNECTION

READ the Scripture for each day on your own. Using the prompts below, take 10 minutes during the day to discuss it with them, either in the car, at the table or by their bed.

DAY 1: READ Psalm 56:3 (KBC Study Bible, page 598)

ASK: What are some of the spiritual weapons God provides for us to fight against evil, and how can you use them to have courage and do what's right?

PRAYER: Pray this prayer daily for your child this week.

I ask that You instill in my child the same courage to stand for and trust in You, even when they feel alone. May they always remember that You are with them. In Jesus' name, I pray, Amen."

Peter **obeyed** Jesus' command to let down the nets and saw a miracle.

I can **obey** God and people in authority over me.

MEMORY LINK

"If you love Me, keep My commandments." John 14:15 (KBC Study Bible, page 1171)

WEEKLY CHALLENGE for KiDs

This week's memory link is something Jesus said, "If you love Me, keep My commandments." Think about ways you can obey Jesus' commandments this week and then tell your parents or an adult in your home.

WEEKLY CONNECTION

READ the Scripture for each day on your own. Using the prompts below, take 10 minutes during the day to discuss it with them, either in the car, at the table or by their bed.

DAY 1: READ Luke 5:1 (KBC Study Bible, page 1110)

ASK: What does it mean when we say that we need to hear the Word of God? How can you make sure you're listening to God's Word?

DAY 2: READ Luke 5:5 (KBC Bible, page 1110)

ASK: How can you show obedience to Jesus in your life, just like Peter did when he obeyed Jesus' command to let down the net?

DAY 3: READ Luke 5:6 (KBC Bible, page 1110)

ASK: Can you think of a time when you obeyed and something good happened as a result? What does that teach us about Jesus?

DAY 4: READ Luke 5:8 (KBC Bible, page 1110)

ASK: How does understanding Jesus' power and His offer of forgiveness help us to be more obedient to Him?

DAY 5: READ Luke 5:10-11 (KBC Bible, page 1110)

ASK: What does it mean to be a "fisher of men"? How can obeying Jesus' commandments help you become a better "fisher of men"?

PRAYER: Pray this prayer daily for your child this week.

"Lord, guide my child in Your ways and instill in them a spirit of obedience. Help them to understand Your Word and to follow Your commandments with a joyful heart. May they experience Your love and grace as they strive to be 'fishers of men'. In Jesus' name, Amen."

HANG 10 PARENT COMPANION LESSON 6: CONTENTMENT

JESUS VISITS TWO SISTERS Luke 10:38-42 (KBC Study Bible, page 1123)

CHARACTER WORD: Contentment – being happy with what I have.

Mary was **content** to be with Jesus while Martha was worried about many things. I can be **content** because Jesus is enough for me.

MEMORY LINK

"For I have learned in whatever state I am, to be content." Philippians 4:11b (KBC Study Bible, page 1298)

WEEKLY CHALLENGE for KiDs

Write a list of things you want and a list of things you need. Contentment is being satisfied that what you have is enough. Ask God to help you be content with the things you have and trust Him to provide the things you need.

WEEKLY CONNECTION

READ the Scripture for each day on your own. Using the prompts below, take 10 minutes during the day to discuss it with them, either in the car, at the table or by their bed.

DAY 1: READ Matthew 6:33 (KBC Study Bible, page 1033)

ASK: What does it mean to seek God first? How can you do this every day?

DAY 2: READ Matthew 6:21 (KBC Study Bible, page 1032)

ASK: What do you love the most? How can you make sure God is the biggest treasure in your life?

DAY 3: READ 2 Corinthians 9:7 (KBC Study Bible, page 1274)

ASK: How can you be a cheerful giver? What can you give to someone else this week?

DAY 4: READ Philippians 4:11-12 (KBC Study Bible, page 1298)

ASK: How can you be content in any situation? What does it mean that God is enough for you?

DAY 5: READ Luke 10:38-42 (KBC Study Bible, page 1123)

ASK: How can you be like Mary and choose what is better? How can you focus on Jesus instead of worrying?

PRAYER: Pray this prayer daily for your child this week.

"Lord, help my child to find contentment in You alone. Teach them to seek You first and to trust that You are enough for them. May they find joy and peace in Your presence, and let their hearts be filled with Your love. In Jesus' name, Amen."

HANG 10 PARENT COMPANION LESSON 7: FORGIVENESS

A SON LEAVES HOME Luke 15:11-32 (KBC Study Bible, pages 1131-1132)

CHARACTER WORD: Forgiveness – to release someone from the consequences of a wrong; does not hold a grudge.

The father's **forgiveness** of his son reflects God's **forgiveness** when a sinner repents. I can know with certainty that when I admit my sins and turn to God, He will **forgive** me.

MEMORY LINK

"And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors." Matthew 6:12 (KBC Study Bible, page 1032)

WEEKLY CHALLENGE for KiDs

Find the tip-in page "The Bible is God's Word" in your KBC Study Bible. **HINT:** It is the 5th page from the BACK of your Bible. These games are designed to help you get the Bible into your brain. Choose one of the games and play it with a family member. Tell your surf team leader what you played and what you learned.

WEEKLY CONNECTION

JESUS TALKS WITH A RICH YOUNG RULER Mark 10:17-22 (KBC Study Bible, page 1087)

CHARACTER WORD: Love - a great affection of the mind and heart

The rich man **loved** following the rules more than he loved God and others. I can know that **loving** God begins with the attitude of my heart.

MEMORY LINK

"For I have learned in whatever state I am, to be content." Philippians 4:11b (KBC Study Bible, page 1298)

WEEKLY CHALLENGE for KiDs

How will you demonstrate your love for God this week? In addition to reading your Bible and praying, write down at least three things you did to show you love God.

WEEKLY CONNECTION

READ the Scripture for each day on your own. Using the prompts below, take 10 minutes during the day to discuss it with them, either in the car, at the table or by their bed.

DAY 1: READ Deuteronomy 6:5 (KBC Study Bible, page 193)

ASK: How can you love God with all your heart, soul, and strength today?

DAY 2: READ Psalm 86:11-13 (KBC Study Bible, page 620)

ASK: What are some ways you can show love to God according to these verses?

CHARACTER WORD: Generosity – an unselfish attitude; willing to share with others.

A widow trusted God enough to be **generous** with all she had. I can give **generously**.

MEMORY LINK

"God loves a cheerful giver." 2 Corinthians 9:7b (KBC Study Bible, page 1274)

WEEKLY CHALLENGE for KiDs

Choose to be generous by giving ten minutes of your time each day to help a family member.

WEEKLY CONNECTION

READ the Scripture for each day on your own. Using the prompts below, take 10 minutes during the day to discuss it with them, either in the car, at the table or by their bed.

DAY 1: READ Malachi 3:10 (KBC Study Bible, page 1018)

ASK: What does it mean to give a tithe to God? How can you give your time to God this week?

DAY 2: READ Acts 20:35 (KBC Study Bible, page 1217)

ASK: How does it feel when you give something to someone else? Why do you think it's more blessed to give than to receive?

DAY 3: READ Proverbs 28:27 (KBC Study Bible, page 700)

ASK: How can you share with someone who may not have as much as you do?

DAY 4: READ Luke 6:38 (KBC Study Bible, page 1113)

ASK: What does it mean that when we give, we make room for God to give us more? Can you think of a way to do something special for someone this week?

DAY 5: READ 2 Kings 4:1-7 (KBC Study Bible, pages 389-390)

ASK: How did God show generosity to the widow in this story? How can you help someone in need this week?

PRAYER: Pray this prayer daily for your child this week.

"Lord, instill in my child a spirit of generosity. May they learn to give cheerfully and unselfishly, just as You have given to us. Help them to understand that it is more blessed to give than to receive. In Your name I pray, Amen."

HANG 10 PARENT COMPANION LESSON 10: PATIENCE

ESAU TRADES HIS BIRTHRIGHT Genesis 25:24-34 (KBC Study Bible, pages 31-32)

CHARACTER WORD: Patience – waiting with a happy spirit.

Esau was NOT **patient** and traded his birthright for the immediate pleasure of a meal. God can help me be **patient** when I don't feel like waiting.

MEMORY LINK

"He who is slow to wrath has great understanding, but he who is impulsive exalts folly." Proverbs 14:29 (KBC Study Bible, page 680)

WEEKLY CHALLENGE for KiDs

Ask your teacher or a parent to remind you when you are being impatient this week to help you learn to be patient in all things.

WEEKLY CONNECTION

READ the Scripture for each day on your own. Using the prompts below, take 10 minutes during the day to discuss it with them, either in the car, at the table or by their bed.

DAY 1: READ 2 Peter 3:9 (KBC Study Bible, page 1354)

ASK: Why does the Bible say God is patient with us? How does this verse show God's patience? How can we show patience like God?

DAY 2: READ 1 Thessalonians 5:14 (KBC Study Bible, page 1307)

ASK: Who are we supposed to be patient with? Why is it sometimes hard to be patient with others? How can we practice patience?

DAY 3: READ Galatians 5:22-23 (KBC Study Bible, page 1283)

ASK: What is the fruit of the Spirit? How can we develop patience as a fruit of the Spirit? How does patience show our faith in God?

DAY 4: READ 1 Corinthians 13:4 (KBC Study Bible, page 1261)

ASK: How can we show love by being patient? Who can you show more patience to?

DAY 5: READ Romans 15:4 (KBC Study Bible, page 1246)

ASK: What can we learn from Esau's impatience? Have you ever regretted being impatient?

PRAYER: Pray this prayer daily for your child this week.

"Lord, help my child to develop patience, to wait with a happy spirit even when it's hard. May they learn from Esau's mistake and value the blessings you've given them. Give them the strength to be patient, reflecting Your love and understanding. In Your name I pray, Amen."

HANG 10 PARENT COMPANION LESSON 11: SELF-CONTROL

JOSEPH'S BROTHERS GET JEALOUS Genesis 37:1-35 (KBC Study Bible, pages 45-47)

CHARACTER WORD: Self-control - doing something even when I don't feel like it.

Today's Bible story is about a series of conflicts and problems that happened because several people failed to have **self-control**.

With God's help, I can have self-control by doing the right thing even when I don't feel like it.

MEMORY LINK

"Therefore to him who knows to do good and does not do it, to him it is sin." James 4:17 (KBC Study Bible, page 1344)

WEEKLY CHALLENGE for KiDs

Share with an adult in your home when you have an opportunity to show self-control.

WEEKLY CONNECTION

READ the Scripture for each day on your own. Using the prompts below, take 10 minutes during the day to discuss it with them, either in the car, at the table or by their bed.

DAY 1: READ Proverbs 29:11 (KBC Study Bible, page 700)

ASK: How can you control your anger? What can you do instead of shouting or complaining when you're mad?

DAY 2: READ Galatians 5:22-23 (KBC Study Bible, page 1283)

ASK: What are the fruits of the Spirit? How can you show them in your life?

DAY 3: READ Isaiah 53:7 (KBC Study Bible, page 784)

READ the Scripture for each day on your own. Using the prompts below, take 10 minutes during the day to discuss it with them, either in the car, at the table or by their bed.

DAY 1: READ Joshua 21:45 (KBC Study Bible, page 248)

ASK: This verse is about how God kept all His promises to the people of Israel. How many of God's promises failed? Can we depend on God to keep His promises?

DAY 2: READ Matthew 28:9-10 (KBC Study Bible, page 1068)

ASK: The women worshiped Jesus because He had risen as He said. What does this tell us about Jesus' dependability? How can we show our trust in Jesus' promises?

DAY 3: READ Psalm 105:1-2 (KBC Study Bible, page 632)

ASK: This verse tells us to make known God's deeds and to talk of His wondrous works. What are some of God's deeds that we can depend on? How can we share these with others?

DAY 4: READ John 3:16-17 (KBC Study Bible, page 1151)

ASK: God sent Jesus to die to pay the price for our sins because He loves us so much. How does this show God's dependability? How can we respond to this promise?

DAY 5: READ John 11:25-27 (KBC Study Bible, pages 1166-1167)

ASK: Jesus told Mary and Martha that He was the resurrection and the life. How does this promise show Jesus' dependability? How can we trust and depend on Him?

PRAYER: Pray this prayer daily for your child this week.

"Lord, I pray for my child to understand and appreciate Your dependability. May they learn from the example of Jesus, who kept His promise and rose from the dead. Help them to trust in Your promises and to be dependable in their own actions and words. In Your name I pray, Amen."
