I can have <u>confidence</u> in Jesus' power to save people from sin.	<b>Nicodemus Talks with Jesus at Night</b> John 3:1-21	<b>John 3:16</b> "For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life."
